

Adoption Information Release Form

According to Article 21 of The Protection of Children and Youths Welfare and Rights Act, "The central authorized agency will keep the relevant information of the identity and health of the adoptee, adoptive parent(s) and birth parent(s)." The purpose of this article is to protect the right of adoptees, to obtain and preserve all documents that pertain to their historical and genetic information, as well as to prevent the incest taboo.

According to this law, the birth parent(s) can enquire and apply for adoption information from the Center. In order to protect the confidentiality and privacy, when the adoptee is under 20-year-old, you can choose whether to consent or not to release adoption-related documents and to contact the birth family for reunion.
